



VOLUNTEER UNIFIED GOLF PARTNERS NEEDED FOR TUCSON GOLF TEAM

Practice Days/Times: Mondays 3:30 or 4:00pm until 5:30 or 6:00pm

Golf Season: Early June until 1st or 2nd Week of November
(The team typically takes a few weeks off in July due to the heat and monsoons.)

Practice Location: Randolph Golf Course in Reid Park (602 S. Alvernon Way, Tucson)

Unified Golf Partner Requirements:

- Some golf course playing experience is required. Unified partners will be playing 9-hole alternate-shot format with an athlete. Partners must have their own clubs, but Special Olympics will pay for the greens fees.
- Some experience working with adults who have an intellectual disability is preferred.
- Unified partners must be age 16 or over.
- **Adult Unified Partners (age 18 & over)** must become a Special Olympics Arizona Class A Volunteer by completing the following online requirements (trainings typically take 45 – 60 minutes each):
 - General Orientation Training
 - Protective Behaviors Training
 - Concussion Awareness Training
 - COVID-19 Safety & Prevention Training
 - Coronavirus Outbreak Training
 - Sign a COVID Code of Conduct Form and Communicable Diseases Waiver
 - Background Check
- **Unified Partners age 16 – 17** must complete the COVID-19 Safety & Prevention Training, the Coronavirus Outbreak Training and have a parent/guardian sign the COVID Code of Conduct Form and Communicable Diseases Waiver.
